Disabilities Recreation Project Trout Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. The Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing derby is a one day fishing tournament held at Howard Prairie Lake Resort.
2. NO FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED. FREE FISHING WEEKEND.
3. The contest is open to all Seniors (60 and over), All adults/children with **disabilities**, who have paid the entry fee, and registered at one of the designated sites prior to or on the day of the Derby.
4. **All entrants must be registered no later than 10:00 am the day of the tournament. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. Employees (and their families) of a Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Tournament and/or designated sponsor are not eligible for any Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Tournament prizes.
6. Prizes will be awarded as outlined below for the largest Trout taken from Howard Prairie Lake by "**legal fishing methods**", during the specified times on the day of the Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Tournament.
7. The largest Trout is defined as the heaviest in weight. In the event that two fish have the same weight, the biggest fish will be the longest in length. Only Rainbow Trout will qualify for prizes; no other species of trout will be eligible for prizes.
8. Prizes will be awarded to the following divisions:
 - **Senior Division (age 60 and up)**
 - **Disabilities Division (ages 4 and up) .**

1st prize	\$500.00
2nd prize	\$250.00
3rd prize	\$100.00
4th prize	\$50.00
9. No frozen or partially frozen will be allowed into the contest. All fish must be in a fresh condition at weigh in and will be subject to inspection by the tournament committee and weighmaster. All fish must be caught the day of and at the designated tournament lake. **All fish will be inspected.**
10. Only one rainbow trout per registered angler may be weighed in and entered into the contest.
11. **Anglers must check in at the Weigh station between 11:00a.m. & 1:00pm to qualify for tournament prizes. NO EXCEPTIONS! Anglers failing to arrive and check in at the weighmaster station by the designated time will not be allowed to weigh in their catch.** (Please allow 45 minutes to get off the lake to get to the weigh-in area).
12. All Prizes and Raffles will be awarded after the weigh in.
13. Anglers must follow all state and Jackson County Park rules while participating in the Disabilities Recreation Project Trout Derby.
14. Anglers entered in the contest may fish from shore, jetty or boats.
15. Application for entry into the Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Tournament constitutes permission by the angler to be subject to fullest of the law.
16. Applications for entry into the Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Derby constitutes an express waiver on the part of each angler of the claims arising out of injury or property damage of any nature or kind sustained while participating in the event or while traveling to and from the event. Each angler agrees by registering to participate in the Disabilities Recreation Project Fishing Derby to hold harmless and indemnify the tournament organizers, sponsors, and their respective agents and employees for any and all sums and expenses of any kind resulting from any injuries or property damage of any nature or kind to the person or property of the angler. Any person accompanying any angler, spectators, or any other persons whether or not such persons are registered in the event. Each angler expressly agrees to assume full and sole responsibility for any injury or damage caused by the angler or by any person accompanying the angler, regardless of cause of the injury or damage.
17. Contest will be held regardless of weather conditions.
18. Decisions of the tournament committee and weighmasters are final and binding regarding enforcement of these rules and the declaration of prize winners.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST ABIDE BY CAMPGROUND, MARINA, PARKING AND FISHING. RULES AND REGULATIONS. ANYONE NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION AND SUBJECT TO FINES.
